## An Engaging Program

The story writing process can be incorporated into assessment tasks as needed; such as using narratives, persuasive texts, recounting experiences, fiction and non-fiction writing.

#### Students...

Students have the opportunity to participate in activities and/or excursions and then teach other kids about what they have learnt through creative storytelling. Students also get personal pride from having their stories published and presented in various formats for future generations to use. Enviro-Stories offers knowledge and positive experiences about the local area for life-long learning.
