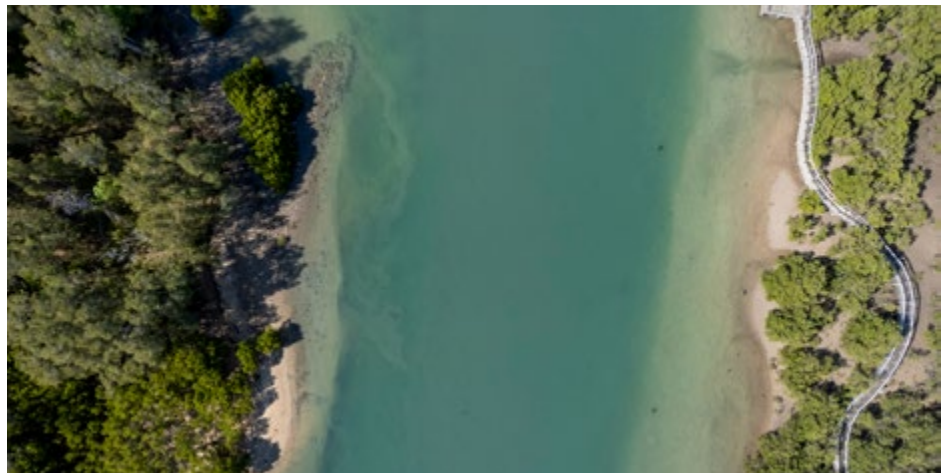

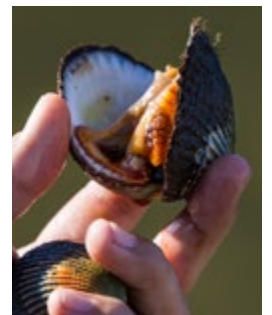
Real fieldwork, photographed honestly — for reporting, funding applications and community engagement. Multiple visits, across seasons, so the images match how the land actually changes.

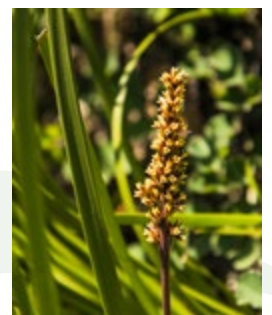
The Spirit of Cullendulla
